Mild- Do questions 1-5 on the first sheet and 1-4 on the second sheet. This does not involve converting improper fractions.

Talk about how adaptation is when a species evolves certain characteristics that allow it to survive in particular habitats. Can the children name four adaptations of a giraffe, lion and rock python that allow them to survive in the wild? Different habitats need different adaptations. These can be physical or behavioural. Ask the children to research an animal from the arctic, desert and marine environment and draw a picture labelling how it has adapted e.g the arctic fox. As an extra, can children think of an animal of their own that could survive in one of the environments. Think about: What does it eat? What is it hunted by? Is it brightly coloured or camouflaged? How does it move? Does it live with other members of the same species or on its own? How does it keep cool or warm? Where does it live? How big is it? Would love to see some pictures of the children's creations.
